Dear IMEA Attendees,

On behalf of Iowa State University and the community of Ames, we want to welcome you to the 2023 Iowa Music Educators Association Conference. It will be an exciting day in Ames on Saturday, November 18 with both the IMEA Conference, All-State Music Festival and a home Iowa State Cyclone football game. The Iowa State vs. Texas game will kick off at 7:00 PM. We anticipate the game ending between 10:00 – 10:30 PM. Due to the expected large crowds, the following are suggestions for arrival to the event:

Thursday, November 16 - Friday, November 17, 2023

- Parking is available in the Iowa State Center (IE: Scheman, Fisher, Hilton and CY Stephens) lots on Friday.
- Friday night, **ALL** lots will be cleared out after midnight. This includes lots north of Scheman. **If cars are left overnight, they will be towed.**

Saturday, November 18, 2023

- No parking is allowed in the Iowa State Center (IE: Scheman, Fisher, Hilton and CY Stephens) lots until 6:30 PM. Attendees should park in **parking lot #56/63** across Lincoln Way, next to the Maple Willow Larch residence hall.
- Beginning at 6:30 PM, parking restrictions will be lifted, and parking will be available in any of the lots surrounding Hilton Coliseum.
- A shuttle will be making a loop from 7:00 AM – 10:00 AM between parking lot #63 and parking lot F to help shuttle people between parking and Scheman. *Please note shuttle times may be delayed due to traffic congestion.
- A shuttle will be making a loop from 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM between parking lot #63 and parking lot F.
- A shuttle will be making a loop from 5:45 PM – 7:30 PM between parking lot #63, 50A&B, and Hilton Coliseum.
- There will be no shuttle after the concert due to traffic congestion. It may be quicker to walk across Lincoln Way to and from Scheman.

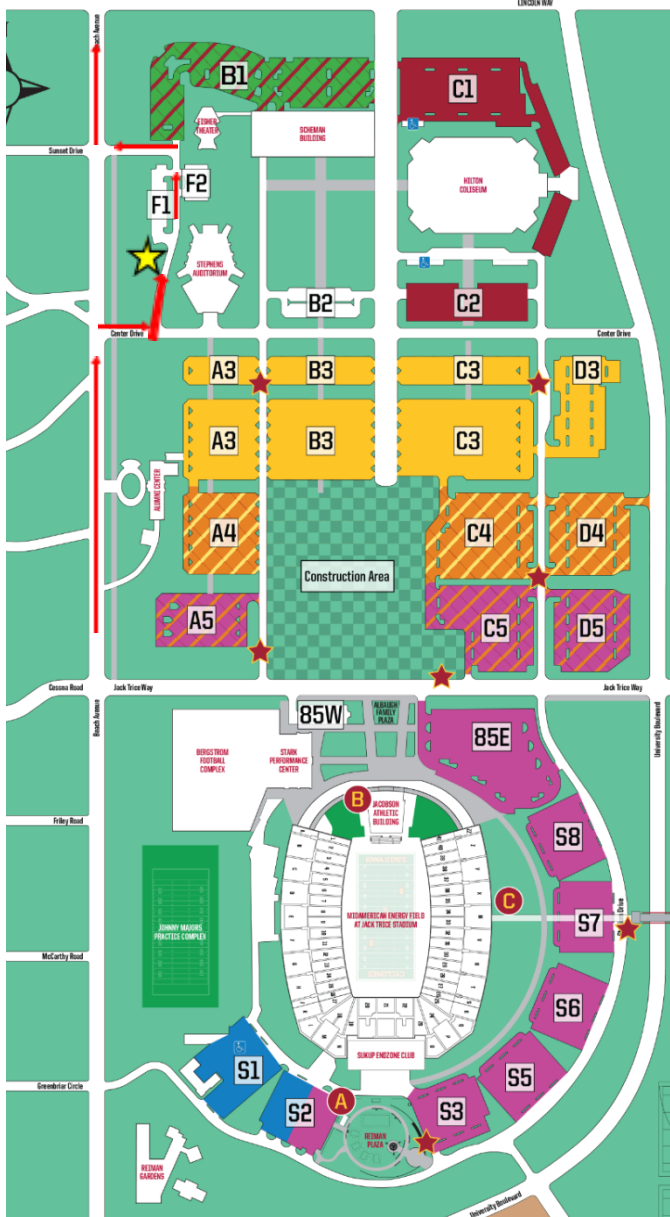
